Remember, once you have your framework and have started to create **Clarity and Common Understanding** (Step 1), you are ready to dig in with teachers about the **Skills, Dispositions, and Tools** (Step 2) they and students need to ensure a student-owned classroom. Be sure to align these back to your **Instructional Framework** (Step 3) as that will ensure you continue to build a common language about the teaching and learning and change perceptions of the rubric as more than just a tool for evaluation. With those aligned indicators you can develop your **Look Fors and Evidence Collection** (Step 4) so that we can better observe for and collect evidence in a student owned classroom. Then, get out and Observe (Step 5)! Keep in mind that anyone and everyone can and should observe as it is the best pathway to a **Culture of Learning!**
