For feedback to feed forward, it must be learner-focused: supporting teachers as reflective learners with a focus on how they impact the learners in their classrooms. Drawing from their books *Learner-Focused Feedback (2020)* and *Feedback to Feed Forward (2019)*, Amy and Patrick will dive into strategies to help you as an observer maximize your time during classroom visits to determine how teachers create outcomes and influence student engagement and learning. Learn to interact with students and analyze cause and effect to ensure feedback becomes a key driver of reflection and learning at all levels.
